


About CSR Partner

West Maharashtra Division at Solapur

On 13th and 14th April'18 CABM along with its CSR initiative organised West Maharashtra Cup. In all a total of 4 teams from West Maharashtra had participated. In this two-day event, players from Solapur, Kolhapur, Pune and Satara took part with great enthusiasm. All the renowned dignitaries marked their presence for the event.

It was a day and night match. On the 1st day 3 matches were held amongst the team Solapur, Pune, Satara and Kolhapur. 1st Match was played between Solapur V/S Pune where Pune won by 8 wickets. 2nd Match was played between Satara V/S Kolhapur where Satara defeated Kolhapur by 10 wickets. It was an amazing win by Satara. The last match of the day was played between Solapur V/S Satara where Satara won by 6 wickets. Excellent cricketing skills were on display by the enthusiastic players from all the participating teams witnessed by the onlookers who were eager to see the cricket played by the blind players.

On the 2nd day total 4 matches were held. 1st match on was played between Pune V/S Kolhapur where Pune won by heavy margin of 126 runs. 2nd Match of the day was between Pune V/S Satara where Satara could not keep up the expectation like their previous victories and lost to Pune by 8 wickets. The last match before the final was between Solapur V/S Kolhapur where Solapur won by 7 wickets. Two tough team Pune and Satara entered the final league, where Pune defeated Satara by 52 runs.



Khandesh Division

Khandesh division matches were conducted at Dhule on 30th April and 1st May 2018. In this two-day event three teams Nashik, Jalgaon and Dhule from Khandesh Division took part with great gusto.

Mr. Ramchandra Patil, Supervising Manager of the MCA Ground and the office bearers, Mr. Ramakant Satam, Secretary CABM and Mr. Ravi Wagh, President CABM inaugurated the tournament. Mr. Patil in his inaugural speech welcomed all the teams and the players and expressed his best wishes for the smooth conduct of the tournament.

On the first day the matches were played between Jalgaon and Dhule, in this Dhule won the match. On the same day the another match happened between Jalgaon and Nashik. Thus, the day ended with two wins by Team Jalgaon.

On the second day, third match was between Team Dhule and team Nashik, wherein Dhule won the match, In the afternoon, the final was played between Dhule and Jalgaon where, Jalgaon ended their victory run by remaining unbeaten in the two-day event.



Mumbai Division

Mumbai division matches were conducted at Islam Gymkhana Mumbai on 12th May 2018. Three teams participated from Mumbai, Navi Mumbai and Raigad. Teams were named as Star 11, Mumbai 11 and Sunrise 11. Shri. Nagesh Thakur, Former Ranji Player was the main attraction at the inauguration and he profusely thanked the efforts by the CABM officials and also the sporting spirit displayed by the enthusiastic players. In his inaugural address He promised CABM for his support in providing grounds or any assistance from his side in the future endeavour.

First match started between Star 11 and Mumbai 11, where Mumbai 11 won the match, 2nd Match happened between Sunrise11 and Star 11, where Sunrise 11 won the Match, the finals was played between Sunrise 11 and Mumbai 11, to which Mumbai 11 won the Match. As a result of the two consecutive wins Mumbai 11 were declared the winners of the Mumbai division tournament.



Vidarbha Division

Vidarbha division matches were conducted at Akola Cricket club ground, Akola on 19th and 20th May 2018. 4 teams had participated from Vidarbha district namely Amravati, Nagpur, Akola and Chandrapur.

Inauguration took place in the presence of Shri. Ravi Thakhur Ranjhi Trophy Player of Vidarbha, Shri. Bharat Dikkar Joint Secretary Vidarbha District Cricket Club and Captain of Akola Cricket Club Ground and Shri. Vishal Gore Doordarshan Editor and CABM officials Shri. Ramakant Satam Secretary of CABM, Shri. Ravi Wagh President of CABM were also part of the ceremony.

Total 7 matches took place. 1st day included 4 matches, 1st match was between Nagpur and Chandrapur where Chandrapur won the toss and remarkably won. On the other side in the 2nd match which was between Amravati and Akola. The winner was Amravati. In the 3rd match which was between Amravati and Nagpur. Where Amravati won the Match. The last match for the day was between Chandrapur and Akola where Akola won the match.

As all the 4 teams had 1 win each. Semi-finals took place between Akola / Nagpur and Amravati/ Chandrapur on the 2nd day. In Akola/ Nagpur match win came in Nagpur favour who easily made 110 without any loss. Where as in the 6th match between Chandrapur and Amravati. In the tough fight Amravati made into finals by scoring defeating Chandrapur who could only score 103 runs from the target of 106 runs. Tough fight between Amravati and Nagpur happened in the finals. Where Amravati won the match by taking 8 wickets of Nagpur. Amravati won by 2 runs.



Marathwada Division

Marathwada division matches were conducted at Guru Govind Singh Ground Nanded. 4 teams had participated from Marathwada district namely Hingoli, Nanded, Aurangabad and Latur. Inauguration took place in the presence of State Bank of India retired officer Dr.Govind Gaud, Voice Secretary of State Bank of India Mrs.Vijaya Laxmi Iyer, Mrs. Sheela Bhaure Mayor of Nanded City, Mr. Aniket Bhaure Son of Mayor, Mr.Suresh Hatkar Corporator of Nanded, Mr. Sangaratna Sonsale Vice Deputy Engineer of Nanded Municipal Corporation, Mr.Bharat Shinde secretary of Marathwada Association of the Blind, Mr.Ravi Wagh President of CABM, Mr.Dadabhau Kute Treasurer of CABM, Mr.Dilip Munde Vice President of CABM were also part of the ceremony.

Total 7 matches took place. 1st match was between Latur and Aurangabad in which Aurangabad won the match. In the 2nd match which was between Nanded and Hingoli. Nanded played remarkable match and won by 9 wickets. On the other side, 3rd match which was between Hingoli and Latur, Hingoli won the match. The last match for the day was between Nanded and Aurangabad Nanded not only won the match but also entered in finals by winning with 9 wickets.

Semi-finals took place between Hingoli/Aurangabad and Latur/ Nanded to which Nanded and Hingoli made to the finals. Where Nanded won the toss and decided to field first. Hingoli scored 102 runs in 10 overs with losing all wickets. Nanded won the tournament.



Konkan Division

This tournament was held on 2nd February to develop Konkan region. 3 teams had participated from the Konkan region namely Sawantwadi, Khed and Rest of Konkan. The inauguration took place in the presence of Shri. Gajanan Naik President of District News Report Association. Total 3 matches took place. In the 1st match Sawantwadi won the toss and decided to bat first and scored 111 runs. Konkan lost the match as they could not reach the designated score. 2nd match was between Khed and Rest of Konkan in which Rest of Konkan won the match by chasing 52 runs in just 12 overs. The last and the 3rd match was between Khed and Sawantwadi. The match was in favor of Khed who beat Sawantwadi who had just scored 67 runs.

Coaching and Conditioning Camps: 5 coaching, conditioning and training sessions were taken in Mumbai the details of these sessions are given below.

Coaching Camp, May 2018

Coaching and training program was taken by Ajay Muni coach for Blind Cricketers. The primary objective was to encourage players to explore their skills outside their comfort zone, in addition to gaining first-hand experience of challenges faced while touring for tournaments. All of this is backed by an assurance of comfortable travel and accommodations as well as engaging learning environments.

No matter how many runs were scored or wickets were taken technical sessions were taken in order to improve the game and take it to the next level. He offered high quality one to one personalized coaching for many players looking to improve their game or any particular skill. Maybe some required batting practice some had to improve their bowling and few on their run up. He also developed catching & ground field skills and work on wicket keeping techniques.



Conditioning Camp, 16th June

Conditioning Camp was organized on 16th June 2018 at Cross Maidan for Mumbai Players. Training was undertaken by Coach Ajay Muni. Total 10 players had been part of this activity. The activity included warm up exercises, strengthening of hands and legs and etc. Players had wonderful time enjoying various innovative leg exercises with football in rains. This activity brought lot of enthusiasm in the players and they enjoyed complete 3 hours learning new techniques.



Training Session, 24th June 2018

Training session inclusive of outdoor and indoor activity. In total 15 players participated. Practice session was taken in reference to polishing batting and bowling of players. In this activity emphasis was given on fitness of B1 players. Together with their fitness exercise for improving their concentration and stamina was major the part. Other category which was B2 and B3 where concentrating on learning new techniques in bowling and batting by Coach Mr. Ajay Muni.



Coaching Conditioning Camp, 8th September 2018

CABM organized Coaching Conditioning Camp for Mumbai Players on 8th September 2018 at Sassaian Cricket Club, Azad Maidan. The session was undertaken by Ajay Muni official coach for CABM. Players had good warm up session and also learned few techniques to improve their play.

CABM specially thanks our chief guest Mr. Laxman Chauhan, who is the Ranji Player from Rajasthan who made the ground available for the players and showed his gratitude in supporting CABM whenever required. Also, he wished all the players luck for better future and also promised to forward his support and assistance.



Coaching Camp Men, 20th & 21st November 2018

Coaching Camp was held for the 17 selected players, who will be representing Maharashtra for the year 2018-2019. Their 1st representation was in Anantpur, Andhra Pradesh for Nagesh Trophy (Ranjhi Format) on 23rd and 24th November 2018. The 2 days camp concentrated more on complex playing technique. The players underwent rigorous fitness drills and warm-up sessions, to step up their energy levels. They were trained in dynamics, catching drills, fielding, wicket keeping, swing and fast bowling. They were also trained on skills to build batting prowess and running drills, bearing in mind the pace at which the game is played nowadays.






Personality Development / Personal Skills Development Session


