CABM is the only recognised body to promote and organise activities relating to cricket for the blind in the State of Maharashtra under the Cricket Association for the Blind in India (CABI), which is affiliated to the World Blind Cricket Council (WBC). Established in 2011, CABM is dedicated to the promotion of cricket for the blind in Maharashtra. CABM organise coaching camps (for men) and tournaments (for men, women and children) and provides infrastructure facilities for players across Maharashtra to hone their craft.






Geographical Location
