CABM organise coaching camps (for men) and tournaments (for men, women and children) and provides infrastructure facilities for players across Maharashtra to hone their craft.







Participation in Bilateral Series



West Maharashtra Inter - School Tournament







In this tournament 4 school had participated from West Maharashtra Division namely Koregaon Park Blind School Pune, Bhosari Blind School Pune, Shahid Major Blind School Pandharpur, and Kolhapur Blind School.

Total 7 matches took place. 1st match was between Bhosari Blind School and Kolhapur Blind School. Bhosari Blind School won the match by 7 wickets. 2nd match took place between Koregaon Park Blind School Pune and Kolhapur Blind School. Bhosari Blind School. Koregaon Park Blind School Pune won the match by 100 runs. 3rd match happened between Shahid Major Blind School Pandharpur and Koregaon Park Blind School Pune. Koregaon Park Blind School Pune won the match by no loss. 4th match took place between Bhosari Blind School and Shahid Major Blind School Pandharpur. Bhosari Blind School won the match 8 wickets.

On the following day 5th match took place between Koregaon Park Blind School and Bhosari Blind School. In which Koregaon Park Blind School again nailed it and won by 28 runs. The 6th match was played between Shahid Major Blind School Pandharpur and Kolhapur Blind School. In this match Shahid Major Blind School Pandharpur won the match by 3 wickets. The final match took place between Koregaon Park Blind School and Bodhadi Blind School. Koregaon Park Blind School won the toss and made a score of 128 runs for the opposite team to chase. Bhosari Blind School could not reach to the chasing score and lost the match with losing out 4 wickets with 68 runs in 10 overs. Koregaon Park Blind School remained undefeated in this year tournament as well as last year tournament. State Level Tournament for the Blind Men

14th and 15th Oct 2019





The major event took place on 14th & 15th October 2019. 6 Division across Maharashtra participated in this tournament namely Mumbai, Marathwada, Khandesh, Vidharbha, Konkan and West Maharashtra. 2 grounds were booked to hold 7 matches in 2 days. 1st match on Wilson Ground was between Marathwada and Vidharbha. In which Vidharbha nailed the performance and won the match by 6 wickets. 2nd match was played at played at Islam Gymkhana between Khandesh and West Maharashtra. In which Khandesh did a splendid performance and won by 1 wicket. 3rd match was again played and Wilson Ground between Marathwada and Konkan in which Marathwada won the match by 211 runs. The 4th match of the day was held at Islam Gymkhana. It was played between Mumbai and Khandesh. In which Khandesh won the match by 8 wickets.

On the 2nd Day i.e., 5th match was between Mumbai and West Maharashtra at Wilson Ground. West Maharashtra won the match by 6 wickets. On the 6th match was Vidharbha and Konkan. Vidharbha again won the match with 221 runs. The final match took place at Islam Gymkhana. Final match was played between Vidharbha and Khandesh. Vidharbha was in great spin of winning and continued their winning streak and won the State Level Tournament by 61 runs. Another major event for the month happened on 16th & 17th October 2019. 6 Division across Maharashtra participated in this tournament namely Mumbai, Marathwada, Khandesh, Vidharbha, Konkan and West Maharashtra. The defending champions were Vidharbha for the year 2018-2019. On the 1st day 4 matches took place respectively. 1st match was between Mumbai and Vidharbha. Vidharbha won by 8 wickets. 2nd match was between West Maharashtra and Khandesh. West Maharashtra won by 72 runs. 3rd match was between Mumbai and Konkan in which Mumbai won by 47 runs. The last match of the day match no. 4 was played between Marathwada and Khandesh, in which Marathwada won the match by 7 wickets.

On the day 2, 5th match was played between West Maharashtra and Marathwada. In which West Maharashtra won by 6 wickets. The 6th match was between Konkan and Vidharbha. In which Vidharbha won the match by 8 wickets. The final took place between the defending champions Vidharbha and West Maharashtra. In which Vidharbha won the toss and elected to bat and West Maharashtra scored 50 runs on board. Vidharbha won the match by scoring 51 runs with fall of 5 wickets and won the tournament 2nd time in the row. Selection Camp Men



Pune

Cricket Association for the Blind of Maharashtra with support from Sony pictures networks Pvt. Ltd. organised the Selection Camp to select the Maharashtra Men team of blind cricket. It took place on 2nd and 3rd November 2019 at N. S. Wadia College in Pune. This camp was organised to select 17 players form Maharashtra team for Nagesh Trophy Tournament (Ranji format). In this camp 40 players had participated across Maharashtra.

The selection process was conducted under the supervision of Pune District Cricket Association Uday Bal and CABM committee members for fair judgments. The following players were selected in 3 categories respectively that are B1, B2 and B3. This team represented Maharashtra in Pune against West Bengal, Jharkhand, and Tamil Nadu on 11th and 12th November 2019 and won all the matches. The matches were conducted on Deccan Gymkhana and PYC Ground. Later this team went to Kochi to play against Andhra Pradesh and Kerala on 21st, 22nd & 23rd November 2019. Maharashtra Team won 3 matches out of 5 and qualified to Quarter Finals.

The selection process took under the guidance of Members from MCA.

This camp was organised to select 17 players form Maharashtra team for National Tournament which is held at Delhi from 16th to 19th December 2019. In this camp 35 players had participated across Maharashtra. The players were selected in 3 categories respectively that are B1, B2 and B3.

Nagesh Trophy Tournament



Cricket Association for the Blind of Maharashtra (CABM) in affiliation to Cricket Association for the Blind in India (CABI), on behalf of them organised 5 Nagesh Trophy Tournament at Pune on 12th & 13th November 2019.

Inauguration took place at PYC Ground with presence of Mr. Parag Mati - Founder of River Cleaning Foundation, Miss. Caraline from Canada and Miss. Jade from Australia volunteers from River Cleaning Project. On 12th November 2019 there were 3 matches were conducted. 1 match on PYC Ground and 2 matches on Deccan Gymkhana.

1st match was between Maharashtra v/s Tamil Nadu at PYC Ground. Tamil Nadu won the toss and elected to field. Maharashtra made a score of 195 runs with fall of 4 wickets. Tamil Nadu could not chase and they lost the game by losing all the 10 wickets. Star players for the match were Akshay Chaudhary B1 scored 42 runs, Anil Belsare B3 scored 78 runs from Maharashtra and Arun Kumar B3 from Tamil Nadu scored 37 runs. Apart from batting in bowling performance Sanjay Ijage B3 and Pravin Karluke B2 took 2 wickets from Maharashtra respectively.

2nd match was between Jharkhand v/s West Bengal at Deccan Gymkhana. Jharkhand won the toss and elected to field. West Bengal scored 138 runs. Jharkhand won in 16.2 over with fall of 2 wickets. Star players for the match were Nishit Williams B3 scored 55 runs, Sujit Munda B2 28 runs from Jharkhand and Prasanjit Adak B3 from West Bengal scored 24 runs. Apart from batting in bowling performance Sanjeev Kerketta B3 took 2 wickets and Rohit Dorah B3 took 2 wickets from Jharkhand.

3rd match was between Maharashtra v/s Jharkhand at Deccan Gymkhana. Jharkhand won the toss and elected to field. Maharashtra scored 165 runs. But Jharkhand could not chase and lost the game by 35 runs. Star players for the match were Dilip munde B2 scored 39 runs and Pravin Karluke B2 scored 33 runs from Maharashtra and Rahul Soren B2 took 3 wickets from Jharkhand.

On day 2, 4th match was conducted at Deccan Gymkhana Jharkhand v/s Tamil Nadu. Jharkhand won the toss and elected to field. Tamil Nadu was all out on 99 runs. Jharkhand easily chased the score and won by 9 wickets. Star players of the match were Rohit Dhora B3 took 4 wickets from Jharkhand. Apart from bowling performance Nishit William scored 33 runs and Sumit Munda scored 18 runs both from Jharkhand respectively.

5th match, Maharashtra v/s West Bengal was also conducted at Deccan Gymkhana. Maharashtra won the toss and elected to field. West Bengal made score of 164 runs with fall of 5 wickets. Whereas Maharashtra chased the score and won the match by 6 wickets. Star players of the match were Anil Belsare scored 72 runs from Maharashtra, Prasenjit Adak B3 scored 55 runs and Dibyendu Mahato scored 55 runs from West Bengal. Ram Borde - Secretary of Vidharbha Cricket Association. Total 3 schools participated in the event namely Dr. Narendra Bhivapurkar Blind School - Amravati, Sarvasamveshak School - Chandrapur and Dyanjoti Blind School - Nagpur respectively. In all 4 matches took place each of 12 overs. The final match happened between Dr. Narendra Bhivapurkar Blind School - Amravati V/S Dyanjoti Blind School - Nagpur. Dr. Narendra Bhivapurkar Blind School - Amravati won the toss and elected to field first. Dyanjoti Blind School - Nagpur scored 159 runs with loss of 2 wickets in 12 overs. In which Amit Borkar scored 57 runs and Suraj Bhothate scored 61 and remained not out. This was 2^{nd} time in CABM's history to organise an event like this. Approximately 60 players had participated in this cricket tournament.

The players were divided in 3 teams namely Pune Warriors, Rest of Maharashtra and Mumbai. 1st match was between Mumbai and Rest of Maharashtra where Mumbai won the match by taking all the wickets of Rest of Maharashtra who could only score 88 runs. In the 2nd match which was between Pune Warriors and Rest of Maharashtra where Pune won by 1 run. The final was between Mumbai and Pune Warrior. But the ultimate Champion was Pune Warriors who scored 111 runs and Mumbai could not the chase the target.

The event was super hit as it was 2nd time in CABM's history to hold a match for Veterans. The man of the match for the 1st match was Harish Kharat who scored 44 runs and in both the other matches Ravi Wagh was man of the match scoring 44 and 31 respectively.

CABM along with SONY PICTURES NETWORKS INDIA PVT. LTD. had organised Khandesh Division School Children Tournament for the Blind at Nashik, Maharashtra. Four teams from Chalisgaon, Malegaon, Nasik Blind School and another from Ahmednagar had participated at Mahatma Gandhi Ground on 9th & 10th December 2019.

In the 1st match Chalisgaon beat Ahmednagar by 10 wickets in the match. Chalisgaon captain Nagesh More won the toss and opted to bowl first. The captain justified his decision and got the opposite team putting low scoring of just 107 runs in 15 overs. 2nd match was between Nasik and Malegaon here Malegon won the toss and elected to field first. But could score only 123 runs with fall of 10 wickets in 17 overs. Nasik easily chased the score and won the match by 5 wickets. 3rd match on day 1 continued it took place between Chalisgaon and Nasik. Chalisgaon won the toss and put a score of 207 in 20 overs. Nasik could not chase the score and lost by 127 runs. 4th match took place between Malegaon and Ahmednagar. Ahmednagar won the toss and elected to field first. They took all the 10 wickets and restricted the score to 134 in 20 overs. Ahmednagar won the match by 3 wickets. On the 2nd day 5th match took place between Malegaon and Chalisgaon. Here Malegaon won the toss and elected to field. Chalisgaon made a fantastic score of 231 in 20 overs. Malegaon could not chase and lost the game by 100 runs. 6th match took place between Ahmednagar and Nasik. Nasik won the toss and elected to bat. They scored 165 runs. Ahmednagar won the match by 3 wickets. 7th the final match took place between Ahmednagar and Chalisgaon. Chalisgaon won the toss and made 215 runs with fall of 6 wickets in 20 overs. Ahmednagar could not chase and lost by very small margin of 15 runs. The openers scored an unbeaten century partnership as Chalisgaon completed a convincing win and lifted the winner trophy.




